Skipped payments are limited to one per year for each loan you have with the credit union. Mortgage loans are ineligible for payment deferrals. Interest will continue to accrue on any unpaid principal balance. Deferrals will result in an extension of loan term.



## **Orange, Texas Branch Closing**

The credit union branch in Orange, Texas will be closing permanently after the close of business on December 31, 2018. Activity at this branch has declined to the point that it can no longer justify the operational expenses required to stay open.

This decision was not an easy one. Management and the board of directors deliberated for some time before determining there was no other viable option. Activity has been monitored closely for the last couple of years and has consistently been trending downward.

We realize this will impact members who still transact business at this branch. Please note that Home Office staff stand ready to assist you in every way we can. Members will still be able to access their accounts via audio, online, and mobile sources as well.
