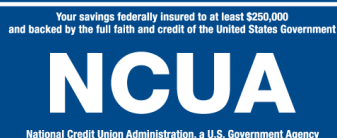

“APPS”olutely Essential Services to Help Keep Track of Your Accounts

We want to be sure members get the most out of their membership so here's a reminder of the apps available to help you do just that. They are available for download from the App Store or Google Play Store. More information 36876 and links can be found on our website.



GP Mobile lets you access your account from anywhere, anytime. You can do just about anything you can when using our NetTeller online banking including view transaction histories, make transfers, find branch 47943 locations, and even pay bills. In order to use GP Mobile you must first contact the credit union and enroll in NetTeller. Mobile banking is initially enabled within NetTeller settings.

Buzz Points is our debit card rewards program. If you use our debit card you can earn points toward rewards each time you make a purchase 701046 with your card. Higher points are awarded for shopping locally which means you benefit from supporting our local communities at the same time they benefit from your business.



MyMobileMoneyAccess is for our debit card users. It is a great way to monitor card activity and mitigate potential fraud losses. You can view recent debit card transactions, see available balances, or locate nearby ATMs. Other features include control and alert preferences. These allow you to restrict purchases and set up 46242 alerts to notify you of card activity. You can also freeze your card if you can't locate it or report fraudulent transactions should you be aware of such activity.

Tips to Get the Most Value from Your Tax Refund

Use your refund for some much needed debt relief. Pay off your credit card balance. If you have an outstanding balance on more than one credit card, try to pay off the smaller, high-interest rate balances first.

Grow your refund. Give yourself an even bigger return on your tax refund by putting the money into a savings account, CD, or 804945 individual retirement account (IRA). Your tax refund will continue to grow if you put it into savings or invest the money.

Consider your financial goals. Trying to save for a house, car or tuition? Apply your tax refund toward these goals. You can set up a special credit union savings account for your specific goals.
